The following is a summary of the discussion following the presentation by Kevin Clark of Sinclair-Hille Architectural Firm after all Masses the weekend of October 6 & 7. The Power Point presentation outlined the site plan and floor plan of the new St. Michael parish.

Saturday, October 6 –5:30 p.m.

- Security and staging – control – window/side light placement and exterior window placement.
 - Side lights not big enough for people to pass through
 - Side light and exterior windows should be offset. .
- Will it be a sustainable/Leed building?
- Parking distribution/to school and church
- Church in the round?
- Want to keep the small parish feel
- Church/school connection?

Sunday, October 7 - 8:00 a.m.

- Adoration chapel/daily mass chapel – capacity 40?
- Number of spaces in rear parking lot?
- playground equipment location
- Distance of parking to front doors
- Porch/Colonnade to entries

Sunday - 9:30 a.m.

- Sloped seating in church? – better visibility like St. Joseph Church
- Possible need for 3 classes of each grade
- Gym distance to parking
- Sustainability systems and building
- Round/tear drop shaped church?
- Org. room/nursing room
- How will church grow/expand if we need more than 700 seats?
- How does St. Joseph handle large gym events for accessibility to all areas of school/church & St. Peter?
- Re-number classroom in addition - #'s are not correct.
- Adoration chapel? Father noted that there would not be one.
