Planning Meeting

February 6, 2009

Father Borowiak and Sister Mary Michael C.K. met with Keith Jaloma and Tim Andrews Friday, February 6 at the School Sisters of Christ the King Motherhouse. Mr. Andrews is the Director of Planned Giving at Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas and Mr. Jaloma is the Development Director for Benedictine College.

The four talked about a partnership with Benedictine College to recruit the best and brightest graduates of Benedictine College to teach in Saint Michael School.

Sister Mary Michael and Father Borowiak suggested that a partnership with Benedictine College could involve contacting interested students in their junior year and interview prospective candidates. A partnership might include tuition assistance and/or a hiring bonus in return for a commitment to teach at Saint Michael School.

Mr. Jaloma and Mr. Andrews said Benedictine College is interested in such a partnership. They suggested that incentives be presented in the form of a scholarship and that Benedictine College is open to contributing to such a scholarship.

The four agreed the next step in the process should be the drafting of a partnership proposal. Father Borowiak and Mr. Jaloma said they will draft elements of a proposal. The proposal will include the objectives and goals of Saint Michael Parish and what Benedictine College will contribute to the partnership.

The four also talked about the role of development and planned giving in a Saint Michael School.
